My Six Point Plan

Improving our roads

Tackling traffic problems in Ashford/Staines

Monitoring gravel extraction in Laleham

Road safety near schools

I will work with schools, parents and pupils to improve crossings, cycle routes and road markings and promote responsible driving and parking around Matthew Arnold, Buckland and Ashford Park school.

Services for the elderly

I will carry on working to help protect elderly and vulnerable residents through involvement with sheltered housing associations and support for our dedicated voluntary groups who deliver essential services.

Protecting public safety

I will continue to work with our emergency services to maintain adequate levels of fire, police and ambulance cover in Staines, Ashford and Laleham.

Denise Turner-Stewart: A Proven Track Record

Returning to the County Council after a by-election victory last year, Denise focussed on resurfacing Woodthorpe Rd, which was the biggest issue for local residents

She has attended planning meetings/site visits and spoken on behalf of residents regarding the Manor Farm gravel extraction application in Laleham, raising strong concerns about flooding, noise, dust and archaeological damage

Traffic, parking issues and surface water flooding are major issues and measures have and are being taken to tackle problems across Ashford and Staines, especially at our busiest road junctions

Denise has been working with local Tree Wardens to protect our green belt by replacing lost street trees and maintaining our threatened grass verges and greens with new tree planting across Staines, Ashford and Laleham

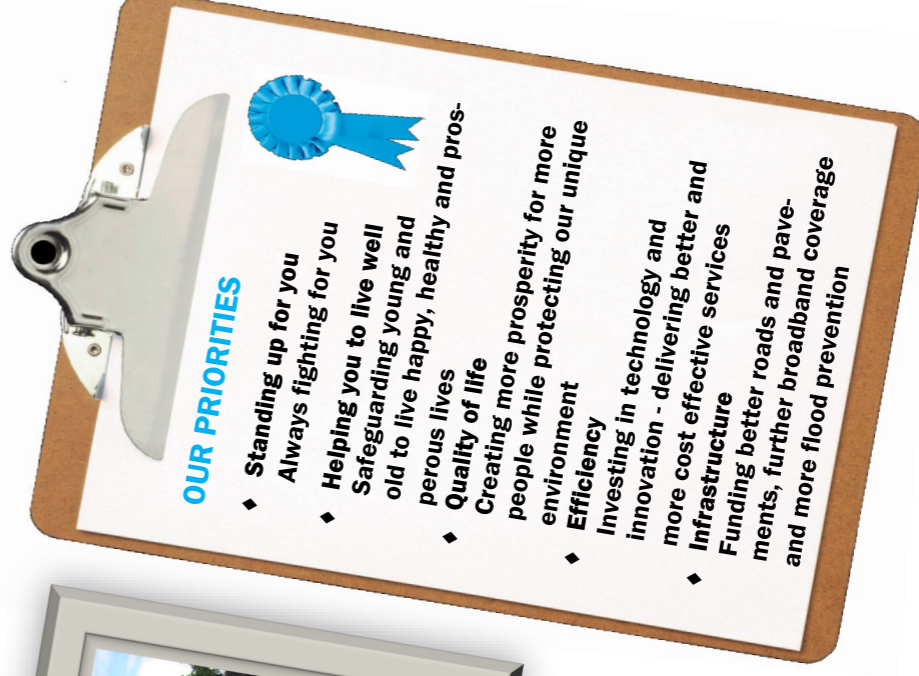
