We've spent millions on extra classrooms and plan to create 11,000 more school places by 2021. Every child must have a school place.

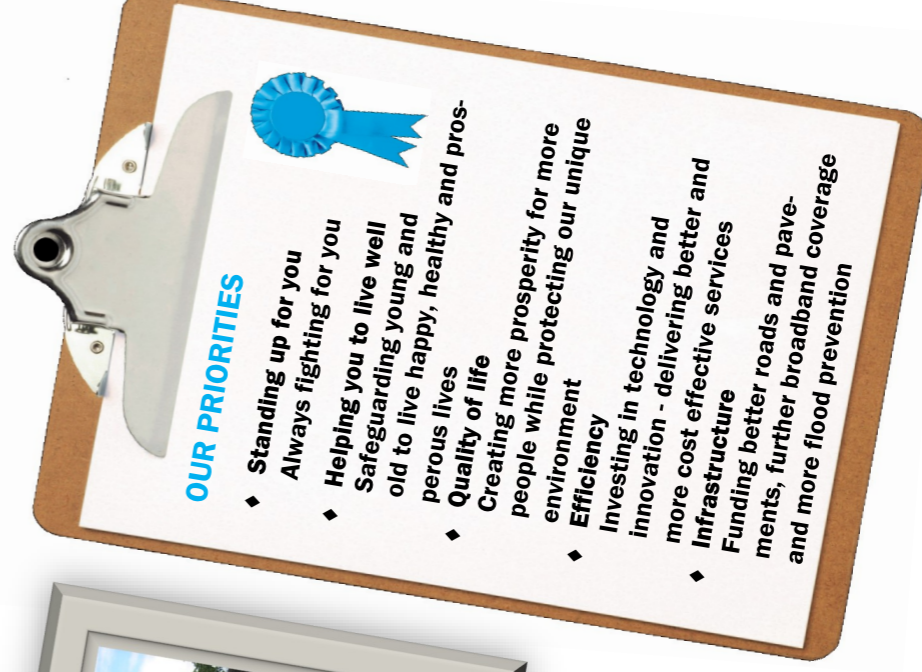
